Applicants must thoroughly read the mandated Application Guidelines

- 1. Run Categories & age eligibility.
 - a. 3 km

The minimum age eligibility to apply for this category is 10 years. (Born on or before 27.01.2013)

b. 6 km

The minimum age eligibility to apply for this category is 10 years. (Born on or before 27.01.2013)

c. 10 km

The minimum age eligibility to apply for this category is 12 years. (Born on or before 27.01.2011)

a. Race day t-shirt

Confirmed participants will receive a race day t-shirt. We will try our best to accommodate the tee size selected by you. However, if unavailable, the next best available size tee will be offered. Any requests for change in sizes/colour will not be entertained.

b. Finishers Medal & Certificate

All finishers will get a finisher medal and certificate after completing their run (please collect your medal before leaving the venue; medals will not be posted to individual runners).

c. Timing Certificate

Timing Certificates of marathon finishers will be available for download from the event website post 3 working days from race day within 14 working days after race day.

d. Bib tagged photographs.

Our photographers will capture you at key locations of the event. You can download your photographs by entering your name or Bib number on our website. The bib must be clearly visible and pinned correctly to the front side of the t-shirt for your photos to be searchable.

8. <u>T-shirt and Running Number Bib Collection Expo</u>

- a. Running number bibs must be collected by all participants on Friday, 26thJanuary 2024.
- b. It is mandatory for all individual participants to collect their running numbers personally from the Bib Collection Centre. Confirmed participants must carry along the following documents to collect his/her number bib:
 - i. Confirmed Application/ Ticket.
 - ii. Govt. approved photo ID proof.
- c. In case of unavoidable circumstances, a runner can send his/her representative to collect the running number bib on his/her behalf. The representative must carry along the following documents for number bib collection:
 - i. Confirmed Application/ Ticket.
 - ii. Govt. approved photo ID proof of the runner(s) and the representative.
 - iii. Authority letter by the runner to collect the kit on their behalf.
- d. No number bibs will be handed over to any participant post the declared closing hours of the expo. No refund will be provided to the applicants failing to collect the bibs.
- e. Race entry packs not collected after 5 pm on the expo day will be deemed as unwanted and the organizer may dispose or re-distribute them accordingly.
- f. Bibs are mandatory for entry to the event. Race entry packs can only be collected on the expo day only.

9. Prize Money Structure

10 km runners will be further classified into age categories for awards and accolades.

The top 3 marathon finishers, men, and women falling within the age groups given below shall be eligible for the following prize money:

While provisional results will be available on race day, timing certificates of marathon finishers/ final results will be available for download post 3 working days from race day.

Only the winners of the 10 km run falling within the prize money structure will be eligible for prize money as mentioned in point no. 06.

Prize money will be transferred within 7 days after declaration of the final result.

11. Parking & Traffic

- No Parking facility will be provided.
- Traffic movement will be restricted on the roads from 4 AM to 8 AM.
- Participants are advised to use public transport and walk to the venue.
- Organizers will not be responsible for vehicles parked in 'No Parking' areas.

12. Other Information

- a. In case any unusual or unidentified object or person is noticed in suspicious circumstances, information should be given to the police.
- b. Please thoroughly go through all information mentioned here prior to submitting your application.
- c. Registration confirmation received will be subject to applicable confirmation criteria and the entry rules given herein.

- d. An applicant can apply for only one race category; multiple applications will entail all entries not being confirmed. Further, an applicant must apply for the event using a single email address.
- e. Finish positions of runners falling within the age groups will be based on net finish times only. Runners must cross the start line within 10 minutes of the official time of the race category, to be eligible for timings, rankings, and thereby prize money (where applicable).
- f. Prize winners declared may be required to submit further proof of identity/age, as may be required by the Event Promoter, for disbursement of prize money, failing which the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, withhold disbursement or disqualify the said participant from the competition.
- g. In addition to the above, entitlement to finish positions and prize money winnings are also subject to-Bib tag timing captured across all timing points on the course, including at the start and finish mats, and Physical verification by technical officials and anti-cheat cameras.
- h. Runners found to have interchanged their running number bib and/or bib tag with others, will be disqualified from the competition. Such runners shall not be entitled to any timing or prize money (where applicable).
- i. Results and entitlement to prize money shall be subject to the rules mentioned herein and the Race Regulations.
- j. Decision of the Event Promoter shall be final and binding on all.
- k. The right to participate in the event and the rights and benefits available to the applicant under this entry form are complimentary and at the sole discretion of the organizer/ promoter and cannot be transferred to any other person under any circumstances. The applicant alone shall be entitled to the rights and benefits arising out of such confirmation of participation.
- I. Confirmed runner's identity, proof of date of birth and residence may be verified for validating the details provided by you in the form. Where any information and/or any document provided by an applicant/runner at any point in time is found to be incorrect, participation of the said runner shall be withheld/disqualified and there will be no refund of application fees paid by the runner. All benefits accruing to the said runner as a participant of Thakur Village Annual Run 2024 shall stand forfeited.
- m. Race day images of all participants will be screened visually after the race and if any of the participants is found not wearing the running number bib allotted to him/her, the participant registered for that bib will be disqualified from the race, and the subsequent edition of the event in 2025. Further, the organizer/ promoter reserves the right to take necessary legal action against the registered participant and the person who has used the running number bib on race day, for impersonation.
- n. Any race day audio, video, or visual recordings made by a participant at the Thakur Village Annual Run 2024 Expo or on race day are to be used only for personal purposes; these cannot be used for any commercial purpose. Complimentary Individual photographs of runners will be available for download on the event website 48 hours post-closing hours of race day.
- o. On race day, participants will be lined up at the start line based on a first come first basis only.
- p. Participants are advised to keep checking our website and social channels for updates on modification of route or schedu.

- 1. I/my ward have provided true and complete information in this application form, and I/my ward am solely responsible for the accuracy of this information.
- 2. I/my ward have fully understood the risks and responsibilities of participating in the Thakur Village Annual Run 2024 or any event outlined in this application (collectively referred to as "the Event"). I/we will be participating entirely at my/his/her risk and responsibility.
- 3. I understand that I/my ward shall participate only on the route designated by the Event organizer.
- 4. I understand that I/my ward must be of an appropriate level of fitness to participate in such a physically demanding Event and that I/my ward have obtained medical clearance from a registered medical practitioner, allowing me to participate in the Event.
- 5. I/we, for ourselves and our legal representatives, waive all claims of any nature against any and all sponsors of the Event, Thakur Village Annual Run Committee members, officials of the Thakur Village Annual Run organizer/promoter, and all other individuals and entities associated with the Event, including the directors, employees, agents, and representatives of any of the aforementioned, for any claims that might result from me/my ward participating in the Event, whether due to illness, injury, death, or otherwise.
- 6. I shall provide Event officials with any medical data related to me/my ward as they may request. I agree that nothing herein shall oblige the Event officials, organizers, or any other person to incur any expense or provide any treatment.
- 7.
